#### Announcements

**Perfect Scores:** This month there were three 100 straights at singles: **Joven Abrenica, Herb Jones, and Al Yapelli.** There was one 50 straight in the doubles event: **Joven Abrenica.** There was also one 50 straight in the handicap event: **Steve Close.** Great shooting, guys!

**Four-Point Pins:** In recognition of the accomplishment of earning four buckle points in a single monthly shoot, this new award was debuted at the Annual Banquet where it was distributed to those shooters who had a four-point shoot anytime during 2016-17. Beginning this year, the Pins are awarded each month with each shooter eligible to earn one each shoot year. We had 14 shooters who earned the maximum four buckle points for last month's shoot: **\*Tony Benigno, Steve Close, \*Gene Crawford, Bob Estrada, Don Gottenberg, Mark Harp, \*Steve Heintz, Ronnie McMahan, \*James Myers, \*Susie Oldham, \*Ron Schaefer, April Vargas, Mike Wirz, and Al Yapelli.** Those shooters whose names appear with an asterisk will be receiving pins.



#### Monthly Awards

**Doubles Award:** The February winner of the Shamrock Leather Double Shell Carrier was **April Vargas** for C Doubles, shooting a 48. This award is rotated through the Doubles Classes with the proviso that you can only win one per shoot year. The class for the March 4<sup>th</sup> shell carrier is B Doubles.

**Monthly Buckles:** The Senior Vet Buckle for February goes to **Hal Chang** for his score of 99. The AAA Singles Buckle for January required a shoot-off between Terry Bilbey, Tony Bonofiglio, John Kinum, and Mike Wirz since they all shot perfect 100's. **John Kinum** emerged the victor by long run over Terry Bilbey, both shooting 99's in February. The AA singles buckle for February goes to Herb Jones, who shot a slick 100. The 21 yard Handicap Buckle winner was **Mark Harp**, shooting a 49. Buckles for the March 4<sup>th</sup> shoot will go to the winners of **Senior Vet, AAA Doubles, and A Singles**.

**Lucky Dog:** Each month a score from 90 to 100 is drawn from a hat. The shooter with the long run at that score wins \$50.<sup>00</sup>, unresolvable ties split the purse. The February Lucky Dog number was **90** and **Ken Seumalo's** long run emerged the winner over Blaine Kolarik and Jane Vujovich who also shot the Lucky Dog score.

**Handicap Champion Award:** In lieu of the regular \$20, we award an Uncirculated Silver Dollar (\$30 value) to the Handicap Champion - the shooter with the high Handicap score for the month, across all yardage groups. Ties are resolved by long run. For February, **Steve Close** wins the Silver Dollar for shooting a perfect score of 50 from the 22-yard line.



**Hunter Awards:** We want to express a special thank you to **Bill and Ruthie Hunter** for providing us with a beautifully engraved silver money clip and a silver dollar pendant. Your generosity in providing these awards helps to make Tri County Trap Club special. We are happy and grateful for your support!



These awards are rotated through the events and classes to provide all members a chance to win. For this shoot year, each member can win one award for each event. Once for Singles, once for Doubles, and once for Handicap, for a total of three Hunter Awards. The January **Hunter Money Clip** winner for A Singles will go to new member **Steve Heintz**, shooting a 99. The **Hunter Necklace** for Ladies Singles goes to **Susie Oldham**, shooting a 96. For the March 4<sup>th</sup> shoot, the Money Clip will go to the **AA Singles** winner and the Necklace to the **Ladies Doubles** winner.

**Handicap Jackpot – with Guaranteed Minimum Payout:** It costs \$2.<sup>00</sup> to enter and you need to have participated in the handicap event for six shoots to establish your handicap distance and eligibility. A score of 50 wins, and if there's no winner, a score of 49 takes half the pot. If the pot is below **\$50.00** for winners or **\$25.00** for half Jackpot winners, the Club will make up the difference. For the February shoot, **Steve Close** earned **\$338.82** for shooting a perfect 50 from the 22-yard Line. **Mark Harp** earned **\$184.75** for his 49 from the 21-yard line, and **Mike Wirz** earned **\$25.00** for his score of 49 from the 27-yard line. The following are the Jackpot balances available for the March 4<sup>th</sup> shoot.

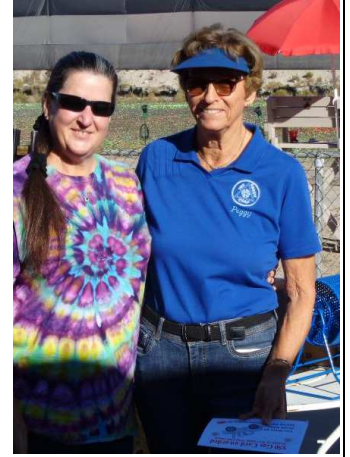

**Practice Rounds:** Practice rounds are not included in your Tri County fees. If you would like to shoot Practice Rounds, please make arrangements with the Redlands Shooting Park office. You will have to purchase a practice round ticket at the counter to present to a field attendant. Field 4 will be set up for doubles and Field 5 will be set up for singles. All other fields will be inoperative. Practice fields will close at 9:00 a.m. sharp for the Awards Meeting, so make sure you can complete your round prior to 9:00. You do not have to shoot in squads. If there is a post open, you may step in during any change of stations. Make sure the leadoff shooter acknowledges your presence to get in the proper rotation. After singles are completed, the practice fields will be open for handicap under the same format but observe a maximum of 2 yards difference between shooters.

**Avoid the check in line:** Use the speed lane. You can pre-squad and pre-pay with Margot (Checks are not cashed until shoot day). She will have your shoot ticket completed in advance. Just check in at Margot's desk to get your copy and your good to go.

Speed Lane means prepaid and pre-squadded.

Pre-squad is the regular sign up line, but you have reserved your squad position in advance.

Please provide all your events including the Lewis and Handicap Jackpot to Margot for Speed Lane calculations. This will allow the tickets to be completed in advance. Let us know your preferred or regular Club squad and post number for Singles and Handicap and we'll do our best to assign those positions to you. If you are shooting as a group, please put your preferred squad/post in one email or phone call. We shoot anytime walk-up Doubles until about noon, so there is no pre-squadding for the regular Doubles event, but we will need to know if you are shooting Doubles at the shoot. Include any questions you may have regarding pre-squadding in your emails or phone call.
